

JOBS

During the initial installation, five scheduled tasks or queue movements are created to execute the processes described below, which are made available for use. The frequency should be configured as needed. For task configuration, please refer to Microsoft's documentation.



We must remember that some templates have their own schedules (days of the week) so the configuration of the Jobs means that they will start on the days or times defined within them, but ultimately they will be subject to the schedule of the templates.



EXPORT REPLICATION (JOB)

This will execute the replication templates that allow it.

For example, in the Export Replication job, all days of the week are selected.


However, for the following template, it will only execute if the 'Allow Job Queue Process' field is marked and only for the designated destinations and calendar days.

The **Enabled** field must be marked in the header, the lines, and the **Targets** section.

TEMPLATE GROUP (JOB)

This will periodically execute Template Groups that have the 'Allow Job Queue Process' field marked and only for custom templates scheduled on the calendar.

The **Enabled** field must be marked in both the header and the lines.




AUTO-RENEW WEBHOOKS

This will renew the expiration date for subscribed notification services where we have marked the 'Automatic-Renew' column.




ENTITY PROGRAMMED

The Entity Programmed task will collect all entries from the Outbound folder (Exports) generated from either base or custom templates and execute them at that moment. It can only process **Copy-Paste**, **Export Data**, and **Run-Process** actions, and it will ALWAYS use data from the same template. For example, for a scheduled Copy-Paste, we must ensure that the template has an appropriate serial number configured in the field settings, the defined filter is set to what we want to process, etc., as there will be no user intervention (automatic process).



Entry in Outbound Folder:



It's important to note that when a template with a scheduled execution type runs, data is not actually selected. If we try to view the data, we will be warned that the generated entity appears empty, which is intentional. Only when the Job is executed will the scheduled data be generated and processed. This option allows us to delay data transmission to a more suitable future time for Business Central resources (e.g., handling large amounts of data) or to wait until users have finished their work to export daily data.

DELETE-CLEAR ENTITIES

With ongoing application use, incoming and outgoing lines will accumulate in the folders, along with their internal content (data).

To prevent unnecessary database growth, we can activate this Job, which will completely delete existing entries and exits along with their operation logs, provided they have been processed and are error-free.

If the 'Clear Entity Only' field is marked in the application's Setup page, the Job will delete only the content of entries rather than the entries themselves.
